



MALAYSIA'S IMPORT REGULATIONS FOR MANDARINS/CITRUS

The Commercial Section of the High Commission of Pakistan has shared the information of Malaysia's import regulations for mandarins/citrus. It is crucial to ensure full compliance with the updated requirements to avoid potential disruptions.

Key points for reference:

- Pesticide residue levels in consignments must not exceed the following limits:
 - Abamectin: 0.01 mg/kg
 - Imidacloprid: 0.2 mg/kg
 - Cypermethrins: 0.3 mg/kg
 - Glyphosate: 0.05 mg/kg
 - Azoxystrobin: 0.5 mg/kg

(Non-compliance may result in fines, return, or destruction of the shipment)

- A 20kg sample must be sent to Malaysia for inspection, with a processing time of 1-2 weeks.
- Lab testing in Pakistan is mandatory for each consignment, and the report must be submitted to the importing company.
- The 3P label must match exactly on both the sample and the container.

(Please review these requirements carefully and ensure adherence for a smooth export process).
